

Women wore this dress on holiday time. It consists of:

1. **TUDISCHINA**, a velvet corsage
2. **SINAVA**, a cotton and silk skirt. The front part, the one covered by the apron, is in cotton to save money. It is long until the ankle. It has a light colour band at about 15 cm from the hem.
3. **FADALI**, a white muslin apron. It has a ribbon to tie it at the waist.
4. **CURVITINA**, it is a white muslin shirt, it is worn under the “**tudischina**”.
5. **QUASETTI**, heavy cotton socks, generally light blue.
6. **SCARPINI**, leather shoes with a ribbon on the front to tie them
7. **MANTELLINA**, a mantle that women wore to go to church.

Women also had a “**spatuzza d’argento**”, that is a clasp for hair and gold hoop earrings or coral earrings.

They also had “a **gulera**”, that is a coral necklace and rings.
